Herefordshire, England



18th century Regency Manor House nestled in the Herefordshire countryside. Previously owned by Lady Pamela Pidgeon and used as an antiques showroom, it is now owned by Martin Miller, the creative force behind Millers Antiques and Martin Miller's Gin. The house has been restored and updated, and is crammed full of inspiring objets d'interets and antiques, in the inimitable Miller style.

Location of house:

Rural; within 5 minutes' drive of a villages with a shop, post office and pubs. 20 minutes drive to Hay-on-Wye and Hereford.

Traditional, 18th century Regency style. Detached property surrounded by grounds, approximately 4 acres.

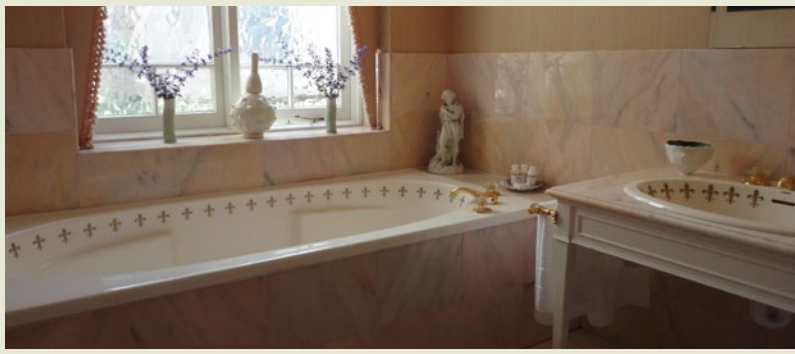
