### OVERVIEW

Nestled in the heart of the Scottish Highlands, Candacraig is an inspiring, exclusive retreat, steeped in history and surrounded by the wild beauty of the Cairngorms National Park.

Originally built in the 17th century and part of a 16,000 acre estate in the Cairngorms, Candacraig was enlarged in 1836 by the same architect that built the neighbouring Balmoral Castle, the Royal family s favourite holiday home. The current owners, Lynne & Marc Lino, bought the property in 2014 from Sir Billy Connolly, a famous comedian/actor who had it for 15 years. Prior to this, Candacraig was owned for many years by the iconic founders of the Body Shop chain Anita and Gordon Roddick. Considerable investment has recently been made into the interior redesign of this stunning property including a wood fired biomass heating system, magnificent chef s kitchen, improved connectivity and upgraded bathrooms with powerful state of the art showers. As a guest at Candacraig, you will enjoy private, exclusive use of the house, including 12 bedrooms with private bathrooms, an impressive formal Dining Room, a comfortable Drawing Room with a large open fire, Games Room with a full-size snooker table, and our guests favourite, the Whisky Library.

Outdoors, you will be surrounded by acres of private woodland and manicured lawns, including a large Victorian walled garden with beautiful flowers and mature trees, a lochan fed by the celebrated River Don and an outdoor firepit and barbeque area, a very special spot to enjoy a drink by the fire. Exploring the lavish grounds you will find one magical setting after another exclusively yours to enjoy during your stay.

# LOCATION

### **Directions to Candacraig**

 Candacraig is easily accessible, whether you are flying, travelling by train or making your own way by car. Those looking to drive may wish to use our postcode, AB36 8XT, to assist with navigation.

### **Travelling from Aberdeen**

• We are less than an hour s drive from Aberdeen International Airport, and only slightly further from the city s rail station, with its frequent services to routes throughout the UK. From the airport, take the A96 towards Inverness, then turn left onto B979 towards Kirkton of Skene. Turn right onto the A944, staying on this road through the town of Alford until you reach the turn off on the left for the A97 towards Strathdon. Continue straight onto the A944 signposted to Corgarff and Tomintoul. The gates to Candacraig are on your left, 2 miles past the village of Bellabeg.

# **Traveling from Edinburgh**

 If you are driving from Edinburgh Airport, take the M90 towards Perth, continue to the A93 North following the Old Military Road through the picturesque roads of Glenshee and Braemar. Turn left after Balmoral Castle onto the B976, left again onto the A939, then right onto the A944 signposted for Strathdon. The gates to Candacraig are on your right hand side after about 4 miles.
