### **OVERVIEW**

Weston Park is no ordinary stately home. Set amongst 1,000 acres of Capability Brown landscaped parkland and former home to the Earls of Bradford, Weston has a rich history, an internationally important art collection and all the grandeur you would expect from a stately home - but with a very modern outlook. The house and its collection are not hidden behind ropes as we operate as an exclusive use venue. With its tranquil location, 27 bedrooms and easy access to major train stations and airports, Weston is a highly sought after venue for private house parties, weddings, corporate events and celebrations. The grounds of Weston Park combine 1,000 acres of natural beauty and three centuries of garden design. The formal lines of the 19th century gardens fuse dramatically with the naturalistic style fashioned by Capability Brown in the 18th century. The park is home to outdoor events, large and small, throughout the year including the CamperJam and Food and Craft Festivals.

- Weston Park is ideally located as a base for exploring not only the grandest of British heritage (Chatsworth 1.5 hours; Powis Castle 1 hour; Chester 1 hour; Shrewsbury 35 minutes; Warwick 1.5 hours; Manchester 1.5 hours; Birmingham 40 minutes) but also offers an ideal opportunity for exploring the Welsh Marches and their remarkable private houses.
- Key museums, such as the UNESCO World Heritage site of Ironbridge Gorge's museums and the Wedgwood Museum are also within less than an hour's drive

Weston Park is situated on the Shropshire/Staffordshire border, on the A45 at Weston-under-Lizzard, just 30 minutes from Central Birmingham 3 miles off M54, Junction 3 and 8 miles off M6 Junction 12. You can also reach Weston Park via the M6 Toll Road.
