LOCATION

Woodland Hall is a beautiful Grade I listed stately home located on the southern edge of the Yorkshire Dales National Park near the town of Skipton, just an hour away from Leeds and Manchester. The estate is on the main A59 only 2.5 miles west of Skipton, with easy access to the motorway network. The estate is very well positioned for walks and other country pursuits and is surrounded by Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty, the Yorkshire Dales, the Three Peaks and the North Pennines.
